We may need to share your medical information in order to refill prescriptions or order additional healthcare with outside agencies.

We may need to contact you and leave information on your answering machine. We will only leave pertinent information on your answering machine.

In an emergency, we may disclose your health information to an immediate family member or a legally responsible party for your health care. When required by law, we will release your medical records.

On each visit you will be given a copy of your transcription for your records. It will be the patient's responsibility to not leave your medical information in cyc's view. When requesting Dr. David Mohler's office to transfer your medical records to another practice there is a fee to cover copying and mailing. We will require a written, detailed and signed request from you the patient.
